

25th Annual Depot Day Festival & Classic Car Show Rules & Regulations

1. To comply with Idaho State tax Laws, tax forms will be distributed at the show. It is your responsibility to display a copy of this form in your booth space during the Show.
2. Booth merchandise must be pre approved for first time participants the festival. Please mail or e-mail a picture of your merchandise for pre approval.
3. Booth fee is \$40.00. Please make checks out to *Northern Pacific Depot Foundation, Inc.* Standard booth size is 10 x10, if you require a larger space you will be charged for additional booth space. The deadline to reserve booth space is May 3, 2010. Space must be paid for when registration forms are returned. No spaces are reserved with out payment. Spaces will be filled as payment and forms are received. A map of the area and your assigned booth space will be sent to you when your payment is received.
4. You may start setting up at 6:00 A.M. the day of the show. You are asked to be set up by 8:00 A.M. And your vehicle parked in the residential area or under the viaduct. You are required to stay open until 5:00P.M.
5. There is a limited access to power. If electrical power is needed for your booth please bring an amply supply of extensions cords, as some long runs may be necessary. Only booths indicating a need for power on there registration form will be placed near a power supply.
6. Food permits are required! Each booth must contact the Panhandle Health district in Kellogg for a food permit.
7. There are food restrictions regarding what you can sell! You cannot sell Bratwursts, Hot Dogs, Corn Dogs, Coney Islands, or any type sausage products. In addition you may not sell carbonated beverages. If you have any questions please do not hesitate to ask.
