Each booth is responsible for its own tarps and coverings. These must be free standing. If electrical power is needed for your booth, please indicate above and bring an ample supply of extension cords. Food booths that have indicated a need for power will be accommodated. Food vendors are allowed 110-volt only. **NO EXCEPTIONS.** Don't forget to bring long-run power cord.

Food permits are required. Each Food booth must contact the Panhandle Health District in Kellogg for the permit. Phone (208)786-7474; fax (208) 786-7019. Please contact the Health District early, they take time to process. Food vendors will not be allowed to set up without a permit.

Every booth will need to have an Idaho Sales Tax Number. The Idaho State Tax Commission can be reached at 1-800-972-7660. You may start setting up at 6:00 am. Friday. You are asked to be completed with set up by 10:30 am. Festival hours are Friday 11am -8pm, Saturday 10am -8pm.

All tables, chairs and other equipment are the responsibility of the booth owner/operator.
